The accused person namely Jatindra Reang is present before this Court by filing hazira through his engaged Ld. Counsel, Mr. U.K. Sarma.

The accused pleads guilty for commission of the offence U/S 177 of M.V Amendment Act, 2019 and beg for mercy.

On perusal of the case record it appears that in present case cognizance was taken U/S 177 of M.V Amendment Act, 2019.

Heard both the parties and considered the matter.

Finding the plea of guilty to have been voluntarily made, I convict the accused person U/S 177 of M.V Amendment Act, 2019.

The accused person shall not be released on probation as the offence committed by the accused affects whole society.

Thus, considering the fact and circumstances of this case, the aforesaid accused namely Jatindra Reang is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- (rupees five hundred) only for commission of offence U/S 177 of M.V Amendment Act, 2019 i.d. of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for 05 (five) days.

Fine money, if realized from the convict, the same be deposited to the Treasury through the Nazir of this Court by Challan.

The case is thus disposed of uncontested.
