

ORDERS ON I.A.II

The plaintiff filed this suit for Permanent Injunction against the defendantS along with I.A No.II u/O. 39 R.1 and 2 R/w section 151 of C.P.C

seeking an order of exparte ad-interim Temporary Injunction against the defendants pertaining to the suit schedule property.

Perused the plaint, I.A. filed U/O 39 R. 1 and 2 R/w section 151 of C.P.C the connected affidavit sworn by the plaintiff and documents placed on record.

Heard counsel for the plaintiff on I.A No.II. At this juncture plaintiff has made out grounds for issuance of exparte ad-interim Temporary Injunction Order. Considering the urgency involved in the matter, notice to the defendant requires to be dispensed with to meet ends of justice. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

By this Order of Exparte ad-interim Temporary Injunction restraining the defendants, their supporters, henchmen, servants, subordinate officials of defendant No.2, agents, representatives and others on their behalf in anyway trying to dispossess the plaintiffs from their peaceful possession and enjoyment or disturbing their possession till the next date of hearing.

This Order shall coming to effect only upon compliance of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of C.P.C.

Issue ad-interim exparte T.I order, after compliance, Emergent Notice on I.A.II, and suit summons to the defendant.
