Along with the present suit, an application under order 39 rule 1 and 2 CPC has been filed, seeking therein ad-interim injunction. The application is supported by an affidavit.

I have heard the arguments of plaintiff. The plaintiff has stated at bar that she was married to Kuldeep Singh in the year 1999 and started residing with her husband in the property in question being married women. The plaintiff was blessed with two sons, out of which elder son is married and his wife is also residing with the plaintiff in the suit property. To prove her possession she has placed on record photographs and aadhar card. The court is of the view that being a married women, she has every right to reside in the property in question. The Court is of the view that *prima facie* case has been made out in the

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favour of the plaintiff, so *ex parte ad-interim* stay has been granted in the favour of the plaintiff. Therefore, the defendants, themselves, or through their attorneys, nominees, assignees, representatives, servants, employees and agents are hereby restrained from dispossessing the plaintiff and her family from the portion of the house i.e. 2 bedrooms along with attached bathrooms, 1 lobby, kitchen and upstairs which is part of house measuring 7 marlas 166 sqft, as fully detailed in the head note of the plaint. It is made clear that this order shall have no effect over the proceedings carried out by the bank authorities or other proceedings pending before the Revenue Authority, if any.

In addition to other modes of service mentioned in Order XXXIX Rule 3 *dasti* summons be obtained and *dasti* service be effected on the defendants at own responsibility.

Compliance under Order XXXIX Rule 3 be made within 2 days from the date of this order otherwise this order shall automatically stand vacated.

Nothing expressed herein above shall have any effect on the merits of main case.

Now to come up on 11.07.2025 for notice to defendants and compliance subject to filing of PF/DM etc.
