Heard learned advocate for the plaintiff on IA.No.1 & 2. This suit is filed seeking relief of Permanent Injunction. Wherein, IA.No.1 is filed seeking dispensation of issuance of statutory notice to the defendants and seeking leave to institute the suit.

2. IA is supported with the affidavit of the plaintiff, wherein the plaint averments are reiterated. Upon careful consideration of the averments made therein, this court is satisfied that if leave is not granted to the plaintiff to institute the suit without issuance of statutory notice and if the plaintiff is made to wait for the prescribed period, then the very purpose of suit gets defeated. Apart from that, this court is satisfied that the plaintiff approached this court by way of this suit seeking urgent or immediate relief in the suit. Hence, the following:

ORDER

Issuance of statutory notice to the defendants as contemplated under the provisions of law is hereby dispensed with and the plaintiff is permitted to institute the suit.
