As per Ahlmad report, record pertaining to the execution petition including award passed in favour of decree-holder, of which execution petition was filed in Kaithal, has not been received so far. Perusal of file reveals that Shri R.N. Bharti, the then Id. Additional District Judge, Kaithal vide order dated 25.10.2016 has transferred this execution petition to the learned District Judge, Karnal for execution of the award passed in favour of decree-holder in arbitration proceedings but when the amount of award not deposited, this execution petition was filed but during pendency of the execution petition, it came on record that JDs/respondents are residing at Kaithal and they have no immovable property in Kaithal. Thus this execution petition was received to the learned District Judge, Karnal and further assigned to this court. Only record of restoration of execution petition was sent. In absence of original record of the award, execution petition can not be proceeded further. Thus the original record be called from the learned District & Sessions Judge, Kaithal for 2.12.2021. A separate letter in this regard be sent to learned District & Sessions Judge, Kaithal.
