

Accused is present. He submits that, he wants to plead guilty. Consequences of pleading guilty are explained to the accused. In spite of it, he submits that, he wants to plead guilty. Hence, the sum and substance of accusation U/s 27(B) of NDPS Act explained to the accused in the language known to him. Accused pleaded guilty. The pleading of guilt by the accused is appears to be voluntary one. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following;

### **ORDER**

Acting U/s 275 of BNSS, accused is found guilty and he convicted for the offence punishable under Section 27(B) of NDPS Act,

Accused is convicted and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.5,000/-** for the offence punishable U/s 27(B) of NDPS Act, in default, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for the period of 10 days.
