The record was not put up by Ahlmad before proceeding on leave and court remained struck at-least for one hour in waiting response from the Ahlmad. So separate notice u/s 36 of The Court Act be issued to him.

The case is listed for arguments and when arguments have been started it transpires that record from the Arbitrator has not been received so far. Perusal of the file shows that even order was not passed inadvertently for calling such record. Without original record arguments can not be heard. So at this stage, a letter of request be written to Arbitrator. Sh. Jagdish Kumar Garg/Sh. Anil Puri/Sh. Naveen Garg, Advocates, as request has been made in this regard and one copy of letter be sent directly through court process. Now for awaiting record to come up on 7.5.2022.
