Examination in chief by the Public Prosecutor.

From 2019 to 2021, I was working as Senior Scientific officer at RFSL, Davanagere.

2. On 10-12-2019, our Office received 5 sealed articles from Santhosha P.C. 1468 of Ripponpete Police station, pertaining to Crime No. 116/2019. Our reception section received the said articles and the same was registered as RFSL/BS/785/2019. The said articles were sent to biological section for chemical analysis and for issuance of report. I have received the said articles and scrutinized the seal over the said articles and the same were intact and tallied with the sample seal.

3. After opening the said five sealed articles, I found the following.

- a. One knife
- b. One shirt
- c. One Jeans pant
- d. One shirt
- e. One Jeans pant

4. I subjected the said articles for chemical analysis and microscopic examination. After examination of the said articles I issued report stating that Items No. 1 to 5 were stained with human blood and Item No.2 and 3 were stained with O group blood and item No. 1, 4 and 5 were stained with A group blood.

5. Regarding the same I have issued report by taking counter signature of Assistant Director in the said report. Now, I see the said report issued by me and the same is marked as Ex.P.20 and the witness signature is marked as Ex.P.20(a).

6. After examining the articles, I repacked the same, sealed it and forwarded the same to the police along with the sample seal of our Laboratory.

7. Now, I see the Five articles examined by me and same are already marked as MO 1 to 3, 5 and 6.

Cross examination by Sri. KNS, Advocate for accused
No. 1 :

8. When I examined the said articles I had experience of 5 years. I do not know whether RFSL, Davanagere had received requisition from the Ripponpet Police to examine the said articles and RFSL Davanagere had returned the said articles to the Police by stating that the Articles were not packed properly. The said articles were sent to RFSL to find out whether the blood stains found on the articles belong to human blood. The police had given requisition to RFSL Davanagere regarding the same. I do not know that the Indian Government has banned benzidine test as it causes cancer.

9. I am not aware of the RH method and We generally will not do RH method in this case. The IO has not sought for opinion whether the blood stains belonged to male or female. I do not know whether the IO had sent the blood samples of the injured and the accused persons to the Lab for chemical analysis. From the five articles, we cut the blood stained part and subject the same for chemical analysis. We are used the entire cut portion for chemical analysis. It is false to suggest that the blood stains has to be examined with in 48 hours from the date of collection of sample.

10. It is false to suggest that the method used by me for chemical analysis is out dated method. It is false to suggest that there was no blood stain on the knife sent to

RFSL. It is false to suggest that the said knife was old and it was rusted. It is false to suggest that I have not examined the articles properly and I have issued false report as per Ex.P20.

Cross examination by Sri. BGS, RHB and CP Advocate for accused No. 2 to 4 :
