Summons issued to Gulam Nabi, Abdul Gani, Abdul Gani Dar, Sona Sheikh, Badrinath, Sohan Lal Chand, Rajesh Nanda, B.R. Sundriyal, Sandeep Sood, Rajender Nath Tatley, Salil Kumar Sharma, Akhilesh Chander Sharma, Gobind Saran Sharma, N.K. Sharma, J.B. Srivastava, Rama Nand and Sarla Devi Sharma received back unserved with the reports that they are not traceable.

Summons issued to witness C.L. Jain received back unserved with the report that his current whereabouts/ address is not available with the concerned office.

The above witnesses are not traceable and even their fresh addresses have not been filed by the prosecution. The case pertains to the year 1986 which is more than 32 years old and one of the oldest

case in this court. Prosecution has failed to file fresh addresses of the witnesses despite opportunity given. Hence, opportunity of prosecution to examine these witnesses stands closed.

Summons issued to witness Sarwan Singh received back unserved. However, bank details where pension of the witness is credited has been mentioned in the report. In view of the same, prosecution is directed to trace the address of witness from his bank details.

Summons issued to witness Vijay Pratap Singh and Lal Chand received back with the report that summons could not be served due to shortage of time. They be summoned again for NDOH.

Let PW24 Satbir alongwith LW6 (as per list of witnesses), Vijay Pratap Singh and Lal Chand be summoned for NDOH.

HIO is also directed to file fresh address/ whereabouts of remaining witnesses by NDOH.
