I S S U E S

1. Does the plaintiff proves that herself and defendant Nos.1 to 20 constituted joint family?
2. Does the plaintiff proves that the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of plaintiff and defendants No.1 to 20?
3. Does the plaintiff proves that the Gift deed executed by defendant No.1 in favour of defendant Nos.19 & 20 with respect to suit 'B' schedule property is null and void and not binding on the plaintiff?
4. Does the plaintiff proves that the Sale deed executed by defendant No.5 in favour of one Ganapathi Bhat in respect of suit 'C' schedule property is null and void and not binding on the plaintiff?
5. Does the plaintiff proves that the Partition deed entered in between the defendant Nos.7 to 10 in respect of suit 'D' schedule property is null and void and not binding on the plaintiff?
6. Does the plaintiff proves that Sale deed executed by defendant No.3 in respect of suit 'F' schedule property in favour of defendant Nos.21 & 22 are null and void and not binding on the plaintiff?
7. Do the defendant Nos.3, 6, 21 and 22 prove that there has already been partition of suit schedule properties vide Zubani Hissa-Patti dated 23.01.1995?

8. Do the defendants prove that the plaintiff and defendant Nos.11 to 14 had relinquished their share in the suit schedule properties as pleaded in written statement?
9. Do the defendant Nos.21, 22 prove that the Gudde Kolluraiah bequeathed the Item Nos.3 & 4 in 'E' schedule and 'F' schedule properties in favour of defendant Nos.2, 3 & 6 vided Will dated 02.03.1995 and thereby the defendant Nos.2, 3 & 6 were the owners of it?
10. Do the defendants prove that the suit 'D' to 'F' schedule properties are self-acquired properties of late Gidda Kollaiah as alleged in written statement?
11. Whether the suit is barred by time?
12. Is plaintiff entitled to the relief of partition and separate possession of 1/15th share in the suit properties?
13. To what shares the defendants are entitled?
14. To what reliefs the parties are entitled?
15. Do the defendant Nos.21, 22 prove that they are the bona-fide purchasers of the suit 'F' schedule properties?
16. What order or decree?
