SUBSTANCE OF ACCUSATION

It is alleged by the complainant that you accused had advanced a sum of Rs. 4,50,000/- from the complainant in respect of property and in order to discharge the said loan amount you have issued a cheque bearing No.557839 drawn on Canara Bank, Sagar branch for Rs.4,50,000/- dated 22-10-2024 and when the said cheque was presented for collection through his banker ie., SBI, Sagar branch, the same was returned unpaid with an endorsement as “**Insufficient of funds**” on 22-10-2024. Thereafter, the complainant issued legal notice dated 6-11-2024 intimating the dishonour of cheque and demanding repayment of cheque amount, in spite of service of said notice, you have failed to repay the cheque amount within the statutory period and thereby you have committed an offence punishable U/s 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act and within the cognizance of this court.
