This Petition coming this day before me for hearing in the presence of Mr. M. Illiyas, Advocate for the petitioner and Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent this court passes the following

ORDER

This is a petition filed under Section 480 BNSS Code of Criminal Procedure for an offense under sections 126 (2), 296 (b), 308 (2), 351 (2) BNS.

1). The case of the petitioner is that he was arrested on 24.07.2026 on a false case and since then he is in Judicial custody .

2). Notice was ordered to the prosecution and they had strongly objected to grant bail to the accused on the ground that investigation is still pending and the accused may tamper with the evidence if released on bail.

3). Heard both sides. Previous Bail petition in Crl.M.P. No.3811/2026, dismissed only on 05.08.2026. No Change of circumstances. The petitioner has 11 Previous Cases and history sheet also. Investigation not yet completed. If the petitioner is released on bail he may tamper with the witnesses and may hamper the investigation. Considering the nature, facts and circumstances of the case, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4). Hence, the petition is dismissed.
