Heard Sri. SK, Advocate for plaintiff on IA No.1.

Perused the plaint averments, document and affidavit filed in support of IA.No.1.

IA.No.1 is filed U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 R/w Sec.151 of CPC seeking an exparte order against the defendants or any one acting for and on their behalf may be restrained from entering into the application schedule property and causing nuisance and harassing plaintiff and his wife in any manner, to part with the properties till disposal of the suit.

Heard the arguments.

By considering the materials on record, at this stage, I found an arguable case to pass an interim order on IA.No.1.

In view of the urgency and apprehension shown by plaintiff, I feel that, an exparte interim order has to be passed on IA.No.1 by dispensing with

the notice to the defendants. Hence, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

Temporary injunction is granted restraining the defendants or any one acting for and on their behalf may be restrained from entering into the application schedule property and causing nuisance and harassing plaintiff and his wife in any manner, to part with the properties in any manner until appearance of the defendants.

The plaintiff to comply order 39 Rule 3 of CPC.

After due compliance, issue emergent notice on IA No.1, TI order and suit summons to the defendants.

For appearance of defendants by 10-12-2025.
