This is an application for grant of interim bail to the applicant/accused Parvesh Mann for a period of 4 weeks on account of a sudden, life threatening cardiac emergency suffered by his aged father and the applicant/accused's father is currently admitted in Aggarsain International Hospital, Rohini, Delhi for treatment.

However, IO has sought some time to file verification report of the medical documents.

But Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has given whereby she has averred that father of the applicant is under going treatment. Statement of Ld. Counsel has been recorded separately in this regard.

Therefore, considering the submissions of party and statement of Ld. Counsel, Hence, interim bail application of accused Parvesh Mann is allowed for one week on humanitarian grounds on furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Ld. JMFC, Ld. Link JMFC, Ld. Duty JMFC subject to the conditions that:

(a) Applicant/accused shall not commit the same offence again and must not threaten the witnesses;

(b) Applicant/accused shall provide his fresh address by way of an affidavit in the Court after his release and in case of any change in his address shall inform the Court;

(c) Applicant/accused shall appear on each and every date of hearing before the Court.

IO is directed to verify the medical documents of the father of the applicant and place the report in this regard on the NDOH.
