

Order on Interim maintenance application filed U/Sec. 23 of protection of women from Domestic Violence Act.

It is contended in the application that the petitioner was married with the respondent No.3 on 22.05.2023 and at the time of marriage the parents of the petitioner spent huge amount and given Gold ornaments to the respondent No.3. The respondent No.1 is father-in-law of petitioner, respondent No.2 is mother-in-law, respondent No.3 is husband of petitioner and respondent No.4 is sister-in-law of petitioner. The respondent No.1 to 3 and petitioner are residing in one house and respondent No.4 is residing in her husband's house. Thereafter, the respondents mentally harassed and physically torture the petitioner.

Further it is contended that without there being any reason the respondents thrown out the petitioner from the house. Thereafter, the petitioner requested the respondents but they did not heed the request. Hence, petitioner files the present application and interim maintenance application claiming Rs. 15,000/- interim maintenance from the respondent No.3. On going through the entire materials available on record and documents produced by the petitioner prima-facie it appears that the petitioner is legally wedded wife of respondent No.3 and respondents mentally and physically harassed the petitioner. Hence, it is prima-facie appears that respondent No.3 is under obligation to maintain the petitioner. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The petitioner is entitled for Rs.8,000/- per month from the respondent No.3 as interim maintenance from date of this order.

Issue Notice on petition, interim application order to the

respondents.

If necessary process is paid.

Call on 18.07.2025.
