

Heard, the plaintiff counsel on
I.A.No.I.

Perused the plaint and
documents made available on record
that, the present suit filed by the
plaintiff for the relief of partition and
separate possession in respect of suit

schedule property. Along with the suit the plaintiff filed application I.A.No.I Under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 of CPC seeking ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against the defendants restraining them from alienating by way of Sale, Pledge or change the Khata the suit schedule property till next disposal of the suit.

At this stage I am satisfied to grant ex-parte temporary injunction. Further the plaintiff has made out a prima-facie case against the defendants from restraining them from alienating the suit schedule property. If the notice is order it may result in delay. The delay may defeat the purpose of suit it become infructuous and will cause to multiplicity of proceedings. Hence, by dispensing the prior notice to the defendants. Hence, I proceed to pass following:

ORDER

The exparte order of temporary injunction is hereby granted in

favour of the plaintiff against the defendants.

The defendants, their agents, servants and others on behalf of them is hereby restrained from alienating the suit schedule property till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply as per provisions of under order XXXIX Rule 3(a) of CPC and file an affidavit to that effect. If the plaintiff is complied as per order.

The office is hereby directed to issue ex-parte temporary injunction order, emergent notice on I.A.No.I and suit summons to the defendants. If PF and copies furnished.
