I worked as senior specialist from 2005 to 2017 a in
Dist, Hospital Tumakuru.

On : 05.09.2013 at 3.30 pm, when I am working as
a casualty medical officer in Dist, Hospital, Tumakuru.
Lakshmaiah S/o Hanumaiah, a/a, 75 years, R/o
Honnenahalii village, Gubbi Taluk, came to Hospital with
history of assault Near B.C kaval, at 10.00 am by
Mahadeviah, Chethana and Nandan by hands and kicking
by legs.

On examination of Lakshmaiah, I found following
injuries.

- 1.Tenderness and pain over back.
- 2.Tenderness and pain over left side chest.

3. Tenderness and pain over right iliac region.

I treated patient and issued wound certificate. Witness identified wound certificate and it is marked as ExP.1 and signature is marked as ExP.1(a). Injuries are simple in nature. It is possible to inflict injuries mentioned in Ex.P1 by used of coconut petiole, hand and legs.

On 5.9.2013 at 3.35 pm. one Kamala, a/a, 34 years, R/o Turuvekere came with history of assault near B.C.Kaval, by Umadevi, Prakasha, Mahadeviah, Chethana and Nandan with coconut shell, kicking by legs and by bricks.

On examination of, Kamala I found following injuries.

1. Tenderness and pain over genital region and back.
2. Abrasion over left arm, 3x2 cm.
3. Tenderness over popliteal region.

All the injuries are simple in nature. I treated patient and issued wound certificate. Witness identified wound certificate and it is marked as ExP.2 and signature is marked as ExP.2(a). Injuries are simple in nature. It is possible to inflict injuries mentioned in Ex.P1 by use of coconut petiole, hand and legs.

Cross examination by: Sri. A.R.U advocate.

It is false to suggest that injuries mentioned in Ex.P1 can be sustained by injured if falls on hard surface due to intoxication. It is false to suggest that injured has not sustained any injuries at the time of examination. It is false to suggest that I issued false wound certificate at the behest of CW.1. I have not conducted medical examination with regard to consumption of Alcohol by injured as there are no symptoms at the time of examination. I am not aware whether injured was asthmatic at the time of examination.

It is false to suggest that injuries mentioned in Ex.P2 can be sustained if the heavier object falls on injured. It is true to suggest that measurement of injury No.1 and 3 was not mentioned in the Ex.P2. It is false to suggest that Ex.P2 issued at behest of injured in order to substantiate their false case.
