Case advanced in view of advancement application filed by the counsel for the petitioner and filed 3 applications under order 22 Rule 4 of CPC to implead the LRs of petitioner and also application under order 22 Rule 9 of CPC to set aside the abatement order if any to filing the LR application and another application under section 5 of Limitation Act along with PF and copy of G. Tree.

Sri SHM advocate has no objections.

All the applications are allowed.

To carryout amendment and to file amendment petition.

Later, amendment carried out and amended petition filed

Petitioner and his counsel present.

Both parties have filed joint memo stating that the matter has been settled and petitioner has agreed to receive a sum of Rs.3,51,931/- as full and final

settlement of all the claims made in the petition.

The contents of the joint memo are read over and explained to both parties. They have agreed the terms and conditions and they are lawful. Hence, joint memo is accepted.

In the result, the petition is hereby allowed in terms of joint memo filed by both parties.

The respondent shall deposit the compensation amount of Rs.3,51,931/- within 3 months.

In the event of failure to deposit the compensation amount within 3 months, the petitioner is entitled for interest at the rate of 6 percent per annum till the date of payment.
