I am working as a Senior specialist since, june 2009 till date in District Hospital, Tumakuru.

On : 04.8.2013 at 12.45 pm, when I was working as a casualty medical officer in District Hospital, Tumakuru. Lakshmaiah S/o late Hanumaiah, a/a, 75 years, R/o Honnenahalli village, Nittur hobli, Gubbi Taluk, came to Hospital with history of alleged assault.

On examination of Lakshmaiah, I found following injuries.

- 1.Pain over both knee joints.
- 2.Head ache and chest pain.
- 3.Pain and tenderness over supra pubic area of abdominal wall.

He was admitted as inpatient on that date and discharged on 7.8.2014.

Surgeon, District hospital Tumakure gave opinion as soft tissue injury.

I issued wound certificate. Witness identified wound certificate and it is marked as ExP.8 and signature is marked as ExP.8(a).

I opined that injuries 1 to 3 are simple in nature and age of the wounds is less than 6 hours at the time of examination.

It is possible to inflict injuries mentioned in Ex.P8 by hand and legs.

Cross examination by: Sri. A.R.U advocate.

I am not aware with regard to statement of CW.1 recorded by police in the hospital. It is true to suggest that I have not affixed my signature to Ex.P1. It is true to suggest that injuries mentioned in Ex.P8 may be sustained person if falls in the agriculture field. Patient was treated by surgeon of district hospital. It is false to suggest that Ex.P8 was issued at behest of police.
