31.07.2024	The case is called out. The complainant and the inquiry witnesses are absent. The case is fixed for inquiry witnesses u/s 202 Cr.P.C. Neither the attendance nor the representation on behalf of the complainant was filed. Perused the case record and on the perusal of the case it appears that in this present complaint case arises out of the complaint filed by the complainant Shekh Abdulla in the court of learned CJM, Sitamarhi on dated 11-10-22, which was made over by him to this court u/s 192 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 11-10-22, for enquiry, trial and disposal in accordance with law. It is also apparent from the record that neither the complainant herself has appeared in this case nor is represented by his pleader since 28-11-22. Several opportunities have been given to the complainant to present before this court and to prove his case. On the previous date, this court has directed the complainant to do proper paivi but in vain. Today also after the repeated call no one has turn up in the present case. Due to the continuous absence of the complainant and in lack of proper pairvi either by the complainant or his advocate shows lack of interest by the complainant and it is difficult to proceed with the inquiry. So, the inquiry is hereby closed. Accordingly, on the basis of the entire materials available on record this court finds that there is no sufficient material and enough evidence on record to proceed further in instant case. Hence, the following orders are hereby passed. ORDER 1) That the complainant petition is hereby dismissed under Section 203 of Code of Criminal Procedure. 2) Officer is directed to preserve the record to the record room within the reasonable time after completing all the procedural formalities.
