As per compromise application plaintiffs and defendant No.1 to 3 have admitted sale deeds execute in favour of Defendant No.4 and 5 with respect of Item No.9 and 10 of suit properties and they will not claim interest in these properties. Hence suit against Item NO.9 and 10 are hereby dismissed. Further as per compromise application A schedule property are allotted to first plaintiff and B schedule properties are allotted to second plaintiff and remaining suit properties are allotted to Defendant

No.1 to 3. Further as per compromise application both the parties have taken possession of suit properties. The contents of compromise application read over to both the parties in kannada language and they admitted the same. Hence compromise application filed U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

In view of compromise between the parties suit of the plaintiffs are hereby decreed.

Draw final decree as per compromise application after paying necessary court fee by both the parties.

The compromise application is part and parcel of decree.
