

ORDERS ON IA NO.1

The interim relief sought is to temporarily restrain the Defendant No.1 from alienating the suit schedule properties.

2. In the affidavit it is submitted that the plaintiffs are the children of one Channigarayappa and Jayamma. The Defendant No.1 is second wife, where without the knowledge of her mother such marriage is taken place. The suit properties are ancestral and joint family properties and therefore the second wife Defendant No.1 and her children do not have any share in these properties. Illegally there has been entires in the original M.R of the name of the Defendant No.1 and has illegally mutated her name without the knowledge of them. Hence has filed this application.

3. Prima-facie has produced the M.R bearing No.2 of 96-97. It is seen that such name of Defendant No.1 has been included. Therefore, the plaintiffs have made out case to try

the suit in order to ascertain the right of the plaintiffs over the suit properties. Therefore, in order to avoid multiplicity of proceedings and that if alienated, hardship would be caused to the plaintiffs, this court proceed to pass the following:

Order

Issue ad-interim exparte order of temporary injunction restraining the Defendant No.1 from alienating the suit properties till next date of hearing.

Plaintiffs to comply under Order 39 Rule 3 of CPC.

Issue notice on IA No.1 and suit summons to Defendants by court, if steps taken.
