BW issued against the accused received back unexecuted with report that the accused was not found at the address. Further the process server contacted the accused on his mobile number and the accused refused to reveal his current address to the process server. Further, the neighbours informed that the accused resides in Bangalore.

Further perusal of the record shows that on LDOH summons were received back served upon the accused through Whatsapp.

Therefore, it appears that the accused is well aware of the proceedings and he is not appearing deliberately before this court.

Let NBWs be issued against the accused upon filing of PF within 15 days to secure presence of the accused.

In case the address of the accused being out of Delhi, the warrants be issued through DCP concerned.

Let the mobile number of the accused be mentioned on the warrants issued, if available on record.

In case of non execution of the warrant, concerned process server is directed to submit a report about the efforts taken for the purpose of execution of the same.

Now to come up for appearance of the accused/further proceedings on 10.08.2026.
