

**BEFORE THE I/C MOTOR ACCIDENT CLAIMS
TRIBUNAL (MAIN), BANASKANTHA, AT PALANPUR**

Order Below Exh. 1 in MACP No.282/2024

(1) Applicant and Opponent No.2 insurer of the errant vehicle reached to amicable settlement in regards to dispute in National Lok Adalat and as such they filed compromise pursis at **Exh.21**. Parties to the petition read over to the same. The terms and conditions of the compromise pursis are admitted upon the parties satisfaction. Compromise pursis is recorded.

(2) The present matter is disposed off in terms of compromise pursis at **Exh.21**. The opponent No.2 shall deposit amount of **Rs.2,45,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs Forty Five Thousand Only)** being agreed settlement amount less payment made if any under NFL, within 3 months in this Tribunal. Failing which the applicant shall be entitled for the yearly interest at 7.5% on awarded amount, after expiry of 3 months.

(3) The opponent No.2 is directed to deposit the amount of compensation through RTGS / NEFT in **Bank Account Details of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Banaskantha at Palanpur**, as under :

(4) Out of the awarded compensation to the claimant 50 % amount is order to be deposited in the Fixed Deposit Receipts in the name of applicant in any nationalized bank of the choice of the applicant for a period of Five(5) Years and remaining 50 % amount shall be paid to the applicant in his/her bank account. above FDR is to be made as per the guidelines of the **Honourable Supreme Court** in the case of **General Manager, Kerala State Road Transport Corporation, Trivandrum V/s. Susamma Thomas and Ors. reported in 1994 (2) SCC 176.**

(5) The applicant is directed to furnish his/her bank particulars i.e. his/her bank account number and branch, IFSC code of concerned Bank and copy of Pan Card before the Registry and thereafter, Registry is directed to make disbursement of the amount of compensation accordingly.

(6) This claim petition against rest of the opponents are disposed off accordingly. The apportionment and disbursement order if any shall be passed after awarded amount is deposited with the Tribunal.

(7) Award be drawn accordingly.

(8) The Applicant is entitled to get refund of Court Fees, if any, paid by the applicant, as per Government Notification No. L/28/09 NALSA, Dated. 14/10/2009 issued by National Legal Services Authority.

(9) Opponents are directed to scrupulously follow the guidelines issued by the **Honorable High Court of Gujarat** in the case of **Hansagauri Prafulchandra Ladhani & Ors. V/s. Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd. & Ors. [2007 ACJ 1897]** in respect of TDS.
