1. Whether the plaintiff proves that, she and defendants 1, 2 & 4 are coparceners of Hindu Undivided Family and the suit schedule properties are their ancestral and joint family properties?
2. Whether the defendants 1, 5 & 6 prove that father of plaintiff and defendants 1 to 3 were partitioned the joint family properties and suit properties on 25.06.1979 in which suit Item No.1 & 2 were fallen to the share of defendant No.1?
3. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the suit is bad for Non-Joinder of necessary parties as contended in para-6 of his written statement?
4. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the suit is barred by limitation?

5. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the suit is not properly valued and court fee paid is insufficient?
6. Whether the defendants No.5 & 6 prove that defendant no.1 and his family members have got executed two registered agreement of sales in their favour on 31.08.2015 with respect to 20.08 and 18 guntas each in Sy.No.85 respectively?
7. Whether the defendants No.5 & 6 prove that inspite of decreeing suits in O.S.321/18 and O.S.322/18 filed by them, the defendant No.1 and his family members are not executing the Registered sale deed, instead they instigated the plaintiff to file this suit?
8. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief sought for in the plaint?
9. What Order or Decree?
