ORDER ON I.A. NO. 1

The plaintiff has filed the present suit against the defendants for partition and separate possession, wherein the petitioner/applicant has filed an application U/O 32 rule 4 and 5 R/W Sec. 151 of CPC with a prayer to permit the petitioner/applicant namely Smt. Sapna S. D/o Shivarudrappa P.N to appoint herself as a natural guardian to her minor daughter to conduct the case on her behalf as the present applicant is none other than the mother of minor plaintiff namely Kumari Niharika M.S. to institute the present suit against defendants and conduct the case on her behalf.

Perused the affidavit annexed to the present application. In the present case the plaintiff i.e. Kumari Niharika M.S. is being minor as such it is necessary to appoint a guardian to conduct or proceed the case on behalf of the minor plaintiff.

Moreover it is pertinent to note that, the applicant / petitioner is none other than the mother of minor plaintiff as such she is the natural guardian to the

minor plaintiff. Hence no grounds to reject the present application, hence I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

I.A. No. 1 filed Under Order 32 Rule 4 and 5 R/W Sec. 151 of CPC by the applicant/petitioner is hereby allowed.

Smt. Sapna S. D/o Shivarudrappa P.N is appointed as a guardian to minor plaintiff namely Kumari Niharika M.S to institute the present suit against defendants and conduct the case on her behalf.
