Nature of offence: U/Sec. 303(2) r/w 3(5) BNS.

ORDER

Accused No.1 and 2 are present and identified by PC No.2413 of PS CC. Kunta. They are examined under section 262 BNSS, heard charges framed and the substances of charge for the offence under section 303(2) of BNS is read over and explained to them in Telugu language for which they pleaded guilty. The admission of accused No.1 and 2 appears to be voluntarily.

Hence, the accused No.1 and 2 are found guilty for the offence punishable U/sec. 303(2) of BNS, and they are convicted under section 264 BNSS.

Heard regarding the quantum of sentence. It was the plea of the accused No.1 and 2 that it was their first offence and that they will never repeat any such offences. Further submitted that they are the only member to look after their families and if they are sent to imprisonment, their families would be put to unforeseen hardship.

Accordingly, accused No.1 and 2 are sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.3,000/- **each** for the offence punishable U/sec. 303 (2) of BNS, In default of payment of fine he shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of One month. Total fine amount of Rs.6,000/- (Rupees Six thousand only).
