ORDER

This is the petition filed by the petitioner U/s.13 (3) of Birth and Death Registration Act.

2. The averments of the petition in brief are as follows :

The petitioner have stated that, the grandmother of petitioner by name Revakka W/o Siddappa (ರೇವಕ್ಕ ಕೋಂ ಸಿದ್ಧಪ್ಪ), died on **03.06.1987** at Ankapura village, Nitturu Hobli, Gubbi taluk. The petitioner have intimated the date of death of Revakka W/o Siddappa to the concerned authority orally within the stipulated period but they did not obtained death certificate. That now the petitioner require the



death certificate of Revakka W/o Siddappa and the petitioner have approached the respondent to obtain death certificate. Therefore, the petitioner have filed application before the respondent office has issued non-availability certificate. Hence, this petition.

3. Inspite of receipt of notice, the respondent did not appear before this Court. Hence, the respondent is placed exparte.

4. The following points arise for the consideration of this Court:

1. Whether the petitioner has made out sufficient grounds to allow this petition?

2. What order?

5. The petitioner in support of their case, petitioner examined himself as PW.1 and relied on the documents which are marked as Ex.P-1 to Ex.P-4.

6. Heard arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the materials on record.

7. The answers of this court to the above said points are as under:

REASONS

8. **Point No.1** : In support of petitioner's case, the petitioner has filed affidavit in lieu of examination in chief as PW.1. In his evidence he has stated that, his grandmother was died on



03.06.1987 at Ankapura village, Nitturu Hobli, Gubbi taluk. But the said fact is not registered in the respondent office. That now the petitioner require the death certificate of Revakka W/o Siddappa to avail Governement facilities. The petitioner has produced and marked 4 documents. Ex.P-1 is the non-availability certificate, which discloses that, the date of death of Revakka W/o Siddappa is not registered in the register maintained by the respondent and Ex.P-2 & 3 are the G-Trees and Ex.P-4 is the notarized copy of Aadhaar card. Inspite of receipt of notice respondent did not appear before the Court. Evidence of PW.1 is not challenged by the respondent. Evidence of petitioner is corroborated by the documentary evidence. Hence, there is no reasons to disbelieve the evidence of PW.1. Hence this court is of the opinion that petitioner has made out ground to allow this petition and accordingly this Court answers Point No.1 in the **Affirmative**.

9. **Point No.2 :** In the result, this Court proceeds to pass the following :

ORDER

**Petition filed U/S. 13 (3) of Registration
of Birth and Death Act is hereby allowed.**

**Respondent is hereby directed to enter
the date of death of Revakka W/o Siddappa,
(ರೇವಕ್ಕ ಕೋಂ ಸಿದ್ಧಪ್ಪ) died on 03.06.1987 at
Ankapura village, Nitturu Hobli, Gubbi taluk
in their registers after collecting fee.**
