JUDGMENT

1. The Inspector of Police, D2 Selvapuram Police Station has submitted the criminal final report U/S 379 IPC.

2. Prosecution case

This case has been filed by the prosecution for the offences u/s 379 IPC alleging that on 18.07.2022 between 13.30 hours to 22.00 hours, the accused has stolen the two wheeler vehicle TVS XL Super bearing Registration No.TN-37-BE-0518 of Balasubramaniam, proprietor of Sreenivasan Uppu Mandi in which shop de-facto complainant Tr.Sivasamy was working and the above said vehicle was used by him which was kept at Chokkampudur, Balaji Nagar, 3rd Street. Site No.2 near Uppumandi.

3. Framing of charges

After giving reasonable time to the accused and furnishing all the copies of the case documents u/s 207 of Cr.Pc, the charges was framed against accused u/s 379 IPC, which was read over and explained to him & asked whether he is pleading guilty or not. The accused replied that he is not pleading guilty.

4. Admission Petition

(i) During the pendency of the trial, the accused have filed admission petition claiming that he is pleading guilty. Accused questioned. Having understood the substance of accusation, the accused pleaded guilty. Hence based on the admission petition of the accused, the accused found guilty and was convicted u/s 248(2) of Cr.P.C. Questioned the accused on the sentences. Pleaded for lessor punishment. The property has been remanded in P.R.362/2022.

(ii) Considering the fact of the case and the nature of the offence, this court is satisfied that, accused can be imposed with lessor imprisonment for a period of 47 days for the offence u/s 379 IPC The period of detention already undergone by the accused during the time of investigation from (21.07.2022 to 05.09.2022=47 days is ordered to be set off u/s 428 of Cr.Pc in the interest of justice.

(iii) The property remanded in P.R. No. 362/2022 has been already returned to the owner of the vehicle Tr.Balasubramaniam, vide CMP No.21718/2022 shall be retained by him and the bond executed by him shall be cancelled after appeal period if any.
