ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN REGULAR CRIMINAL BAIL
APPLICATION No.1221/2026
(Harpritsingh Sidhu Vs. State of Maharashtra)

1. The applicant is seeking regular bail through this application under Section 483 of BNSS in connection with Cr.No.68/2026 registered with Badlapur East Police Station under Sections 143(2),143(3), 318(4), 335, 336(3), 337, 339, 340(2), 125, 271, 272, 61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, under sections 27 B(ii), 18(C) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, and under sections 28, 29, 33 of The Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act, 2021.

2. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicants, Ld. APP and the Investigating Officer.

3. **Case of the prosecution in short is such that :**

The first informant was informed by the Civil Surgeon, Thane regarding bogus and illegal IVF Center being run in the vicinity of Badlapur. Accordingly, a raid was conducted with the help of police and it was found that the applicant and co-accused were involved in illegal activities of collection of ovum (woman eggs) and its distribution. They were also creating false and forged documents to run such illegal business. On the basis of aforesaid allegations, FIR came to be registered against the present applicant and other accused. The applicant was arrested

on 20.03.2026. According to the prosecution, the applicant has prepared the forged documents and Adhar Cards on the say of co-accused persons by using Sejda.com website for commission of the abovesaid crime.

4. Through this application, it is the submission of applicant that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. Investigator is complete. There is sole allegation against the applicant that he is allegedly prepared Adhar Card and other identity documents of certain donor women. He is not at all connected with any other co-accused persons or with the crime. He is ready to abide each and every conditions imposed upon him while releasing him on bail.

5. Prosecution has filed say at Exh.4 and submitted that the applicant has prepared the forged Adhar Card and Identity documents of donor women by using Sejda.com website on the say of co-accused. Co-accused Amol Patil has paid the cash amount to the present applicant and his wife for the said work done by him. The applicant has committed the serious crime.

6. It is argued by the Ld. Advocate for applicant that the co-accused Dr. Nikhil Kishor Chitnis, Vandana Amol Patil and Sandhya Nitin Jadhav have been released on anticipatory bail by an order dated 28.05.2026 by the Incharge of this court. The co-accused Satish Chaudhary having played the same role, was also been released on bail. Therefore, applicant is seeking bail on the ground of parity.

7. Considering the fact of the case, the applicant is in jail from 20.03.2026. Investigation is completed, chargesheet is

filed, therefore, keeping him behind bar for uncertain period is not warranted. Hence, I proceed to pass following order:-.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Applicant **Harpritsingh Sukhdevsingh Sidhu** be released on bail in Cr.No..68/2026 of Badlapur East Police Station for the offence punishable under Sections 143(2),143(3), 318(4), 335, 336(3), 337, 339, 340(2), 125, 271, 272, 61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, under sections 27 B(ii), 18(C) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, and under sections 28, 29, 33 of The Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act, 2021, on his furnishing P.B. and S.B. of Rs.50,000/- along with one local surety in the like amount, on the conditions that;
 - (i) The applicant shall attend each and every date of this proceeding.
 - (ii) The applicant shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer.
 - (iii) The applicant shall not tamper the prosecution evidence, witnesses in any manner.
3. Breach of any of the above said condition shall result in cancellation of bail.
