The accused has forwarded these applications to sought permission to produce documents annexed with these applications on record.

2. It is submitted by the accused that, the matter is posted for the defence evidence of the accused. He wants to produce the order passed by Labour Court dated 29/04/2022 and copy of email dated 01/04/2019 along with certificate U/s. 65 (B) of Indian Evidence Act. It is submitted by the accused that, these documents are important for the just decision of the case and therefore prayed to allow the applications.

3. The complainant has filed his say on the backside of these applications. It is the submission of the complainant that they denied these documents. The documents are required to be proved. Therefore, prayed to reject the application.
