Judgment:-

The above-named accused have been sent by the SHO,
Police Station Bhattu Kalan, Fatehabad to face trial for commission of

offence punishable under section 3, 4 and 13 of Public Gambling Act (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act', for short).

2. Briefly stated the prosecution case is that on 04.07.2021 in the area of P.S. Bhattu Kalan, Fatehabad, accused namely, Jai Parkash @ Jaipal son of Gharshi Ram being the owner of your house/room constructed in your field, Bhattu Kalan, Fatehabad knowingly and willfully used the aforesaid room for the common gaming house i.e. playing card with money at stake and the remaining accused except Jai Parkash @ Jaipal were also found indulged in playing card money at stake in the aforesaid room of accused Jai Parkash @ Jaipal. On the basis of this, the present case was registered. Investigation was started and the accused were arrested. Statements of the witnesses were recorded. After completion of all other necessary formalities, challan under section 173 of Cr.P.C. was prepared and presented in the Court for trial.

3. Copy of challan and other accompanying documents were supplied to the accused persons free of costs in compliance of section 207 of Cr.P.C. Notice of accusation under sections 3 and 4 of Public Gambling Act was served upon the accused persons, to which, they pleaded guilty and did not claim trial.

4. The accused desired to confess their guilt. Their joint confessional statement has been recorded separately. They are accordingly held guilty for the offence punishable under Section 3 and 4 of the Act.

Order:-

Joint statement of convicts is recorded separately. Heard on quantum of sentence. Keeping in view the nature of offence, antecedents and other attending circumstances that the convicts are poor persons; that the act of confession of the convicts has resulted in saving the time and energy of the Court, I am of the view that ends of justice would be met if the convict Jai Parkash @ Jaipal son of Gharshi Ram is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.100/- for his conviction under Section 3 of the Act and remaining above named convicts are sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 100/- each for their conviction under section 4 of the Act. In case of default in making the payment of fine, they shall undergo simple imprisonment for 1 (one) day. Ordered accordingly. Fine paid. Case property, if any be disposed of after expiry of period of appeal or revision if any. File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
