Claim petition under section 166 of M.V. Act for the compensation of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rs. Twenty Lakhs only) for the injury of petitioner, M.V. Accident involving Vehicle Ashok Leyland Ltd. Goods Carrier Truck bearing Reg. No. MH-13-DH-3334, Occurred on 18-04-2024 at about 02:30 p.m, Near Borale Vast, in the limits of Village Korvali, Tq. Mohol On Mohol-Mandrup highway.

This Case is coming on this day for final disposal before **Sri. Sushant Mahaveer Chougale, B.A. LL.B.(Spl.), III Addl. Senior Civil Judge & M.A.C.T Kalaburagi**, in the presence of Sri. U.G. Patil, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri. Santosh S.K, Advocate for the Respondent No.1 and Sri. V.V. Chandraki, Advocate for the Respondent No.2. It is ordered and Award that:

The petition filed by the petitioner U/s 166 of M.V. Act is hereby partly allowed with cost.

The petitioner is entitled for the compensation of **Rs.9,82,870/-** with future interest at the rate of 6% p.a., from the date of petition till its realization.

The respondent No.1 being the owner and respondent No.2 being the insurers of the offending vehicles involved in the accident are jointly and severally liable to pay the compensation to the petitioner.

Respondent No.2 is hereby directed to deposit the award amount with interest within 30 days from the date of petition till its realization.

As the petitioner has spent amount towards hospital and medical expenses and the case is of the year 2024, hence the petitioner is entitled for release of 70% and remaining 30% shall be deposited in the name of petitioner in any of the nationalized or scheduled Bank for a period of 1 year.

The concerned bank shall not advance any loan on such deposits or shall not release any part of the amount deposited, before expiry of the FD period or without order of the court.

Advocate fee is fixed at Rs.1,000/-.

Costs of petition is fixed at Rs.1,000/-.
