

The plaintiff has filed IA U/O 11 rule 1 of CPC and prayed to direct the DW.1 to produce the original parikath dated: 15.04.1995. On the other hand, the defendants No.1 to 4 have filed objections. Heard. Both side.

While cross examination the DW.1 has admitted that, he has no difficulty or problem to produce the original palupatti or panchayath parikath. In this case the plaintiff has contended that, the Ex.D7 i.e., certified copy of panchayath parikath dated: 15.04.1995 is manipulated. Therefore, it is proper to directed the DW.1 to produce the original panchayath parikath dated: 15.04.1995. The contention taken by defendants will be considered at the time of disposal of the suit. Hence, the application filed by the plaintiff

is deserves to be allowed.

Further, the DW.1 is directed to produce the original panchayath parikat or palupatti dated: 15.04.1995 in the next date of hearing without fail. If the DW.1 has failed to produce the said document inference will be drawn against the DW.1.

For compliance and further cross of DW.1 finally by 23.07.2026.
