The SHO was asked to file the report about the action
taken on the complaint given to him on 15.03.2024. The relevant
portion of the report filed today is reproduced as under:-

*“That as per available record of Police Station, complaint
dated 15.03.2024 filed by Shri Balraj Singh, Senior
Manager, BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. against Mohd. Shahid,
S/o Mohd. Sabir R/o 7401, 3rd Floor, Lalan Wali, Quresh
Naar, Delhi alleging theft of electricity was received at
Police Station Sadar Bazar vide DD No. 84-A dated
15.03.2024.*

*That the said complaint was marked to HC Surender No.
1565/N, the then Enquiry Officer (Presently posted at PS
Sarai Rohilla), by Inspr. Kanhaiyua Lal Yadav (The then
SHO, PS Sadar Bazar) for conducting an enquiry in
accordance with law. After conducting the enquiry, HC*

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Surender filed the complaint. And, the said complaint was returned to BSES office, through Advocate Shri Parvez Alam, counsel for the complainant company, who regularly represented BSES and used to collect such complaints from police stations.”

The law prescribes that the police is bound to register a case and initiate the investigation if a complaint disclosing cognizable offence is filed with it. If the police is of the opinion that the police action is not required on such complaint, then report is required to be filed by Officer In-charge of the Police Station before the court.

In the present case, in view of the report where after conducting the inquiry the complaint was filed, let DCP, North to file the record of the inquiry conducted by police alongwith the final order passed by the SHO thereby filing the complaint concurring with the opinion of the inquiry officer as well as the report filed to the Electricity Court.
