Notice issued to the accused not received back in any form. A perusal of case/papers shows that notice/intimation issued to the accused repeatedly and matter being pending since 2022. But since then neither the accused has appeared before the Court nor the prosecution has tried to produce the accused before the Court for disposal of the challan in question. It seems that prosecution does not have much interest in the disposal of the challan in question. Moreover, this Court also gathered an impression that the accused is having notice and knowledge of the pendency of the present challan and is avoiding his service deliberately. Hence, in order to prevent the wastage of ink and paper and by taking into recourse the provisions of Section 258 of Code of Criminal Procedure the proceedings of the challan in question are hereby dropped. Papers be consigned put up again whenever the accused is produced before the Court or accused himself appears before the Court or otherwise.
