Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.P.Ramjipathi, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Puthiamputhur P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 09.04.2026 u/s.126(2), 296(b), 308(4), 109(1), 351(3) of BNS Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 09.04.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, petitioner trespassed into the de-facto complainant's house, abused with filthy languages, attempted to murder him with an



intention to commit extortion and also criminally intimidated the de-facto complainant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 09.04.2026 for the past 87 days and this is the 2nd bail application and the earlier application was dismissed by this court in Cr.M.P. No.2616/2026 dated 27.05.2026 and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of police, Puthiamputhur police station has appeared before this court and stated that this petitioner is having 19 previous cases.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the criminal antecedents of the petitioner and though the earlier bail application was dismissed on 27.05.2026, since there is no change of circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition stands dismissed.
