Examination in Chief by Public Prosecutor

From 2022 to 2023 December, I was working as Medical Officer at General Hospital, Pavagada.

On 30.06.2023 at 9.45 A.M. Injured Ramesh brought with history of assault accompanied with CW1 said to have been caused on 30.06.2023 at 8.35 A.M.

I have examined at 09.45 AM On examination of Ramesh I found following injuries.

1. Lacerated wound over head measuring 8 x1 C.m.
2. Left orbital edeme (Contusion)
3. Left letral aspects of neck swelling present

C.T. brain shows no intracranial bleed.

I am of the opinion that the above injuries are simple in nature, Accordingly I issued the wound certificate. Now I see the wound certificate before this court it bears my signature same is marked as Ex.P4 and witness signature marked as Ex.P4(a).

I treated the patient.

Iron rod Mo1 shown to the witness. If assaulted with MO1 iron rod injuries noted in Ex.P4 could be caused sustained.

Cross examination: Sri. P.C.K.R Counsel for accused.

The Injured was not brought to the hospital with a police reference. When the injured arrived at the hospital, the police were not present. I did not mention in the wound certificate that the injured was accompanied by Govindappa. It is true that the contents of the wound certificate are based on the entries made in the MLC register. It is true that the timing has been overwritten. It is true that I did not mention the name of the person who assaulted the injured in Ex.P4. I did not delete anything in Ex.P4 by applying whitener. It is false to suggest that Ex.P4. Was created at the instance of the police. ;It is true that if a person falls on a hard surface, the injuries noted in Ex.P4 could be sustained. In the MLC register, I mentioned injury No.3 as neck trauma with forehead swelling. It is true that there is a difference between injury No.3 mentioned in the wound certificate and the MLC register.
