Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.M.Ganeshan, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Sipcot Police Station, for Respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 11.05.2026 u/s.103(1), 238(a) of BNS. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 14.05.2026.



The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with the co-accused have murdered the deceased.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 14.05.2026 for the past 54 days and that the Accused No.4 and 5 have got anticipatory bail before the Hon'ble High Court in CrI.OP(MD) No.10525/2026 dated 18.06.2026 and this petitioner is not present in the occurrence place and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Sipcot police station has appeared before this court and stated this petitioner took the deceased from the occurrence place through a car and further stated that the investigation is still pending.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the fact that, since the investigation is still pending, if the petitioner is enlarged on bail, there is every possibility of tampering the witnesses and hampering the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
