At this stage, accused has appeared and requested for cancellation of B/w.

Heard.

On oral request, B/w of accused are cancelled.

The gist of allegations have been explained to the accused present today. A notice u/s 283 IPC has been framed against the accused **Umesh Kumar Ram S/o Sh Gudar Ram**. Accused submits he wishes to plead guilty for the offence punishable U/s 283 IPC . He has been apprised of the legal consequences of same. Upon insistence of accused, his plea has been accepted.

Accordingly, in view of his plea, accused **Umesh Kumar Ram S/o Sh Gudar Ram** is convicted for the offence U/s 283 IPC

Arguments on point of sentence heard.

No previous conviction is alleged against him. In view of same and taking a lenient view, the convict **Umesh Kumar Ram S/o Sh Gudar Ram** is admonished U/s 3 of Probation of Offenders Act.

Bail bonds of convict stands cancelled. His surety, if any, stands discharged. Original documents of convict or his surety be returned to them against acknowledgment after cancellation of endorsement, if any.
