Petitioner and his counsel Sri.NR and Sri.NVN advocate for respondent No.2 present.

Both counsels filed joint memo by compromising the matter. The respondent No.2 has agreed to pay the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) as full and final settlement towards compensation claimed by the petitioner. The respondent No.2 has agreed to deposit the said amount within 3 months and on failure to deposit the same, has agreed to pay the interest from the date of award.

The contents of the joint memo is read over and explained to the petitioner. Petitioner has consented for the terms of joint memo.

On perusal of Joint memo, it seems that the compromise is voluntarily. Therefore, there is no legal impediment for accepting the joint memo filed by petitioner. Accordingly, compromise is accepted.

After deposit of the compromise amount, the compensation amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) shall to be released in favor of petitioner through K2 after proper identification.

Draw award accordingly.
