Ld. Defense Counsel files and moves a petition u/s. 206 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and submits that the accused person namely **Nayan Das** wants to plead guilty of all charges levied against him. The substance of the accusation is read over to the accused person u/s. 251 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on being asked the accused person admits his guilt and prays for pardon from this court.

Heard the submissions of the Ld. counsel for both the sides and considered the same. Perused the documents and pleadings on record.

It appears from the record that the accused has been booked u/s. 290 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 wherein the punishment prescribed is fine or imprisonment. Accordingly in consideration of the provisions of Section 253 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 the accused is convicted to pay fine of ₹ 100/-, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for 02 days.

Ld. Defense Counsel makes payment of the fine amount for and on behalf of the convict in open court. Deposit the fine amount with the Judicial Cashier with proper receipt in the Fine Check Book.

Accordingly the convict is directed to be released at once with respect to the present case. Note in the Trial Register.
