Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru. S.Mahendran, Advocate for the petitioner and in the presence of the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side. Upon perusal of available records before this court and on consideration of oral representations made by both side, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 15.05.2026 u/s. 296(b), 329(4), 351(3) of BNS and u/s. 4 of TNPHW Act and u/s.25(1A) of Arms Act. Petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 16.05.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner trespassed into the house of the defacto complainant's lady, abused her with filthy words and attacked her with



prohibited aruval and also made criminal intimidation against her and thereby the petitioner harassed the defacto complainant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 16.05.2026 for the past 12 days and that both the defacto complainant and the petitioner are neighbours and in the alleged occurrence, no person sustained injury and that due to personal vengeance, this case has been falsely foisted against the petitioner and that the petitioner is nothing to do with the alleged commission of offence and that this case was falsely registered against the petitioner only for statistical purpose and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised strong objection to release the petitioner on bail by stating that, the complainant is a house wife and the petitioner is her neighbour and the petitioner used to create problems in drunken mood and on 15.05.2026 night also he created problems in drunken mood and since the complainant warned him, the petitioner trespassed into the complainant's house, spoke abusive words, tried to attack with Aruval, threatened and went away.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that, the petitioner is in custody for the past 12 days and no serious objection raised on the respondent side, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

i) The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Srivaikundam,



ii) The petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from the date of release until further orders,

iii) If the petitioner breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIRSCW 5560),

iv) And if the petitioner, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the petitioner u/s.269 of BNS.
