ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT - 607

1. Heard learned Advocate for the accused no.1. Read the application and papers on record. Upon the applications of the accused it has been submitted that they intend to prefer an appeal against the conviction and sentence before the Appellate Court and seek the benefit of suspension of sentence under Section 389(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The accused are on bail.
2. Today, the accused no.1 is convicted for the offences punishable Under Sections 13(2) read with 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and under Sections 120B read with 420 of the Indian Penal Code. So he sentenced maximum for a term of 3 years i.e. not exceeding 3 years. As per submission on behalf of the accused, assured the Court that they intend to prefer an appeal. There is no adverse facts / things on record against convicted persons.
3. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, and the provisions of Section 389(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, following order ensues:

ORDER

- (1) The sentence awarded to the accused no.1 - **Jeevanige Srinivasa Rao @ J. S. Rao**, shall remain suspended for a period of 30 days from the date of this order to enable the accused to file an appeal and apply for bail before the

Appellate Court, on a condition that the accused shall pay the fine amount.

- (2) The accused no.1 is granted interim bail upon furnishing a personal bond of Rs.25,000/- each with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of this Court.
- (3) The accused no.1 shall surrender before this Court after expiry of above period unless an order of further suspension of sentence or bail is passed by the Hon'ble Appellate Court.
- (4) The accused no.1 shall not leave territory of India without prior permission of this Court and shall keep the Court informed of their current address.
