Ms. Srishti Aggarwal, Ld. Counsel for the accused through VC.

Ld. Counsel for accused seeks an exemption from personal appearance on behalf of the accused stating the fact that accused is traveling to Kolkata to participate in a business exhibition. Copy of travel ticket is also annexed with the application.

Upon query, it is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused, the said tickets were booked one or two months back.

The said request for exemption is opposed by the Ld Counsel for the complainant stating that the accused has not furnished the bail bonds since 2023 and multiple exemptions have been sought on behalf of the accused.

Heard. File perused.

Perusal of the record shows that bail bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- have not been furnished by the accused in terms of order dated 16.08.2023.

On the LDOH, last opportunity was granted to the accused to furnish the bail bonds.

Despite that exemption has been sought on behalf of the Ld. Counsel for the accused.

Further, the LDOH was 11.04.2026 and the traveling tickets were booked after granting today's date of hearing.

Accordingly, application for exemption from personal appearance stands dismissed.

Let NBWs be issued against the accused through SHO concerned on filing of PF within one month, returnable for next date of hearing.

No application for cancellation of NBWs shall be entertained without proof of advance notice to the complainant.
