ORDER

Heard on the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS
filed by above named accused/applicant in the above noted case FIR.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State and
record from the concerned police station was also requisitioned.
3. As per allegations of the prosecution, the instant FIR has
been registered in the present case on the statement of Chamkaur Singh
alias Golu son of Mangal Singh son of Dass Singh, resident of Adarsh
Nagar, Chugha road, Dharamkot, District Moga, who got it recorded that
he is resident of above mentioned address and is a labourer. On
18.11.2025, at about 3.00/3.30 p.m., when he reached in front of bus stand
Dharamkot, on his motor-cycle make Splendor, then the persons came

from backside on motor-cycle encircled him and had thrown him on the ground after kicking leg to his motor-cycle. All these persons were having muffled faces. Then Jaswant Singh alias Janta son of Iqbal Singh, resident of Bhatti Basti made a lalkara that don't let him scot free. He tried to ran away, but they all encircled him and Jaswant Singh @ Janta who was having a sword in his hand, gave a sword blow upon him and he (complainant) raised his left hand for his rescue, then the blow hit on his left hand and ring finger and the second blow hit on his left elbow and the other blow hit on his right elbow and the other blow of sword hit on his left elbow. Then Vijay Jalalabad gave a baseball bat blow on his head and then he again hit the same on his right arm. Then Bhushan resident of Jalalabad gave an iron rod blow on his left shoulder and the unknown person, to whom he can identify, but do not know his name, had encircled him and when he (complainant) tried to ran away, said person handed over him to the other persons. On seeing the persons gathering at the spot, they all fled away from the spot on their motor-cycle. On hearing alarm, his father Harbhajan Singh, who was crossing there, came there, who arranged the vehicle and got him admitted at Civil Hospital Kot Ise Khan, from where, he was referred to Civil Hospital Moga, where he was medically examined. On 21.11.2025, he got recorded his statement at Civil Hospital, Moga, so, action be taken against the accused persons.

4. Learned counsel for accused/applicant argued that applicant is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed any alleged offence. He is not involved in alleged occurrence and his name has been given due to political faction of the village. He further contended that applicant/accused is in custody since 14.06.2026.

Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time, so, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. With these submissions, he requested for granting bail to the applicant.

5. Per contra, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor contended that in view of the seriousness of the offence so committed by the accused/applicants, they do not deserve any kind of leniency. He prayed that keeping in view of the seriousness of the offence, bail application of the applicant may kindly be dismissed.

6. I have gone through the record of the case. As per FIR, the present FIR was registered against present applicant on the statement made by complainant Chamkaur Singh for causing injuries on his person. The injury attributed to the applicant/accused has been declared as simple in nature. The applicant/accused is in custody since 14.06.2026. The veracity of the allegations can only be ascertained during trial. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant. As such, keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case and the fact that accused is in custody since the date of his arrest and it will take considerable time for conclusion of trial, therefore, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody for longer period. As such, the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bonds and surety bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate with the following conditions:

1. *That he will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.*

2. *That he will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.*
3. *That he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.*

Police record be returned and bail application file be consigned to the record room.
