3. Whether the defendant No. 1, 4 to 6, and 10 to 12 proves that, half share in plaint schedule item No. 2 fallen to their share?
4. Whether the defendant No. 1, 4 to 6, and 10 to 12 proves that, written statement 'A' schedule properties are also liable to be partitioned?
5. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to the relief of declaration as prayed?
6. Whether the plaintiffs are alternatively entitled to the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed?
7. Whether the defendant No. 1, 4 to 6, and 10 to 12 are entitled to the relief of declaration as prayed?

8. Whether the defendant No. 1, 4 to 6, and 10 to 12 are alternatively entitled to the relief of partition and separate possession as prayed?
9. What Order or Decree?
