1. Case called out.
2. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that an anticipatory bail application on behalf of the petitioner was allowed by this Court vide order dated 26.03.2026 passed in ABA No. 1742/2025 with direction to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 15 days of the order. He further submits that the petitioner is working in Air Force and posted at Jaisalmer (Rajasthan). That the petitioner did not get leave from his service therefore he could not surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within the stipulated time. Therefore, it is prayed to extend the period of surrender before the Ld. Trial Court. The Ld. Counsel further prayed that a DASTI order also be provided to him.
3. The Ld. P.P. raised no objection.
5. Heard both the sides. Perused the case record and order dated 26.03.2026 passed in ABA No. 1742/2025.
6. Hence, considering the submissions of the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, the prayer is hereby **Allowed**. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 07 (Seven) days from the receipt / production of this order and the other conditions laid down in order dated 26.03.2026 passed in ABA No. 1742/2025 shall remain intact.
7. Let a copy of this order be provided to the petitioner in DASTI.
8. The office is directed to send a copy of this order to the concern Court immediately.
