Suit received by way of entrustment. Report of reader perused. It be registered. Alongwith the present suit plaintiff has also filed an application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC for restraining the defendants from interfering into the peaceful possession of the plaintiff over the shop in dispute.

In order to substantiate his claim, the plaintiff has placed on record documents i.e. photocopy of adhar card of Neelam, photographs, affidavit and death certificate. Prima-facie case is made out in favour of plaintiff. In order to preserve valuable rights of the plaintiff qua the shop in dispute, both the parties are directed to maintain status quo with regards to possession over the shop, fully detailed in the head note of the plaint, till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is under obligation to serve the defendants through RC/AD as well as also under obligation to make compliance under Order 39 Rule 3 failing which the relief granted herein-above shall stands automatically vacated. The notice to the defendants be issued separately as well for the date fixed i.e. 28.02.2024.
