Both the petitioner No.1 and Petitioner No.2 file their respective haziras. Today is fixed for hearing of the Mat. Suit. The record is taken up for hearing of the Mat suit.

The Mat. Suit was filed before the Ld. District Judge, Hooghly on 19.05.2025 and thereafter the same has been transferred to this court on 01.06.2026 for disposal.

This is an application u/s.13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the parties on 19.05.2025. The marriage in between the parties namely Smt. Tara Routh and Sri Dipak Routh was solemnized on 28.11.2019 according to Hindu Rites and Customs. Out of their wedlock one male issue was born on 23.11.2021 namely Divyanshu Routh. The parties have not been able to live together due to estrangement, test, habit, manner, behaviour and style of livelihood between them despite best efforts of the parties to adjust each other. They are living separately since 15.03.2024 and there is no relation as husband and wife in between them. Both the parties are not willing to lead conjugal life as husband and wife. Both the parties now pray for divorce by dissolving their marriage. Both the parties filed their respective affidavit in chief. The petitioner no. 1 and 2 are examined as P.W.1 and P.W.2. Self-attested photo copy of Aadhaar Card of petitioner no.1 and photo copy of birth certificate of her child are marked as Exbt.1 and Exhibit-2 respectively and self-attested photocopy of Aadhaar card of petitioner no. 2 is marked as Exbt.3.

Both the parties have also filed child custody affidavit with respect to their son namely Divyanshu Routh. Both sides have also filed standard parenting plan and an agreement between the parties regarding the welfare of their child in accordance to the standard parenting plan.

Carefully perused the materials on case record. There is no legal proceeding between the parties pending in any court of law in India even there is no connivance between the parties of this suit in instituting of this case. The mutual consent of the petitioner has not been obtained by force, fraud or undue influence. There is no chance of reconciliation between the parties. There is no collusion in between the parties to present this application. Subsequently, they filed the instant application Under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 on 19.05.2025 before the Court of Ld. District Judge, Hooghly praying for divorce on mutual consent. The cause of action arose on and from 15.03.2024 when the parties started to live separately.

I think that there is no impediment to decree the suit.

Court Fee paid is sufficient.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the Matrimonial suit being No. 240/2025 be and the same is decreed on mutual consent. The marital tie in between Smt. Tara Routh and Sri. Dipak Routh which was solemnized on 28.11.2019 according to Hindu Rites and Customs is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent with immediate effect u/s.13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

The decree be drawn up accordingly.
